

What is a Haiku?

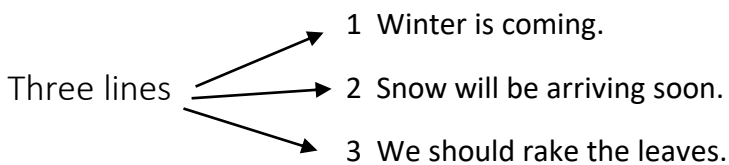
A Haiku is a traditional Japanese art form.

There are always 3 lines in a Haiku

There are always 17 syllables in a Haiku.

- 5 syllables in line 1
- 7 syllables in line 2
- 5 syllables in line 3

Here is an example:



1 Win ter is com ing.	5 syllables
2 Snow will be a rriv ing soon.	7 syllables
3 We should rake the leaves.	5 syllables
