

## What is a Rights Respecting School?

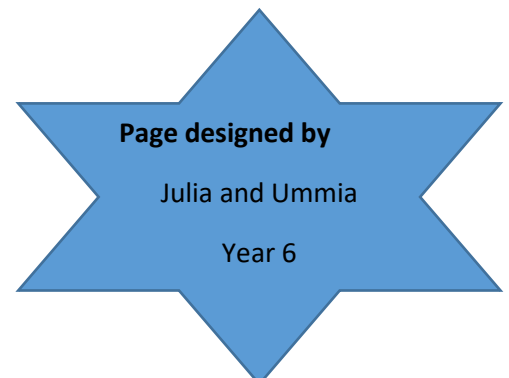
### Putting children’s rights at the heart of school

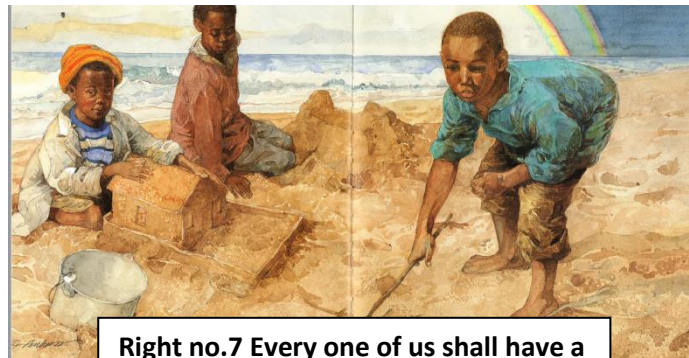
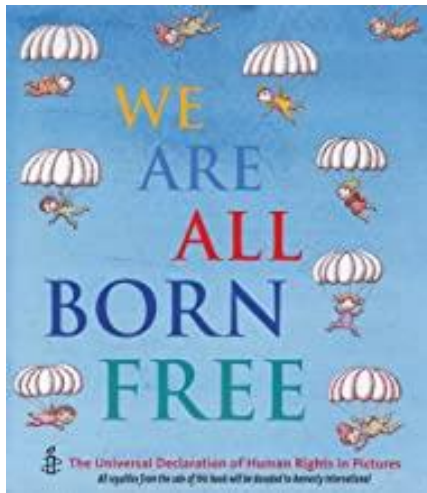
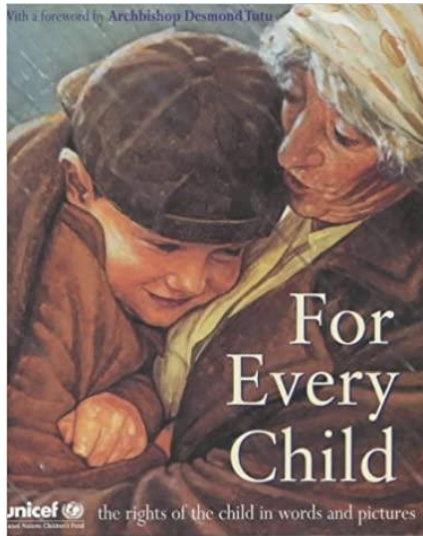
The Award recognises a school’s achievement in putting the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child into practice within the school and beyond.
